# **Donating In Memory**

You can donate in memory of a loved one online by using the **Donate** button on our website by going to <u>www.queenscourt.org.uk/donate</u>

When you make your donation, you can tell us the name of this special person and, if you would like, you can also tell us more about them and why you are donating.

# **Collecting at a Funeral or Memorial Event**

Collecting donations at a funeral in aid of Queenscourt can make a lasting difference in memory of your loved one. You might choose to do this by asking for donations instead of flowers. You could also hold a collection at a celebration of life service or memorial event.

We can provide collection pots for use at funerals and memorials, and we also have additional resources available such as donation envelopes, pin badges, and cardboard collection boxes.
